Dark Matters Unifying Matter, Dark Matter, Dark Energy and the universal Grid by Percy Seymour

I am not sure that this book is legitimate – not from a legal viewpoint but from a scientific one. The first half or more of the book has to do with magnetism, magnetism everywhere. Magnetism is quite abstract and not easy to understand from drawings. Insufficient background is given to absorb what is presented. By the middle of the book one is asking what all this has to do with dark matter and dark energy. Then some physics and history we all know is presented and finally near the end of the book is something called "The Plasma Space Theory of Matter", which I think the book is about.

It may be that this book is a shadow of a mathematical and scientific framework that makes sense to those who trod higher up on the mathematical landscape than a math drooler. I do not see where it adds any new understanding to dark matter or dark energy, at least, not to the common person with an interest in such things.
